

# Street and Evening Shoes Necessity For Every Woman

## Lower Heels Seen for Wear On Street; Brogue, Oxford And Strap Pump, Forecast

Satin Pump in Plain or Brocaded Effect as Well as Metal Pumps are Needed for Evening Wear; Vamp Lines are to be Longer

What style of shoe shall we women buy for our winter year? To answer the question it will be well to determine how much we have to spend and what its demands for wear will be.

For the average woman or girl two types of shoe are a necessity, the street shoe and the dress shoe, and a third for evening wear is very difficult to do without.

The street shoe this year will have a slightly lower heel than last, and may be either a brogue, a tie oxford or a Spanish heel, strap pump.

The strap pump may be worn for all day and informal evening appearances. The brogue, and the oxford makes a good business shoe if the proper kind of clothes are worn with each. A silk or crepe dress looks rather "queer" with a pair of brogues acting as understudy, while a pair of tie oxfords may easily appear with such clothes. Sweaters and skirts, tailored wool dresses and any typical sport costume appears to splendid advantage with a good looking pair of brogues.

**Satin Pump For Night**  
For evening, satin in plain or brocaded effect and metal pumps are the thing. Of course plain satin is the best to get if one is being economical, because as long as evening shoes are worn plain satin will be good, and the style of the evening shoe does not change radically in so far as standard models are concerned. There is always a few novelty creations and unusual styles but the economical buyer will avoid any hint of unusual or extreme styles, in any type of clothing, be it shoes, dresses, or accessories.

If one does not have to consider the pocket book the shoe field this year is an enchanting place to linger. There are so many kinds of leather and so many charming styles which of course will change with the spring and summer but which will be a joy for two or three months at least.

**Two Rules to Remember**  
There are a few rules to remember in buying shoes this year. Only the novelty and cheaper shoes will be colored, this with the exception of midnight blue, which will be very good in the best shoes. The vamp, the line from ankle to toe, will be longer. Only the extreme shoes will carry the short vamp. The heels are slightly lower, and the low brogue heel will be exceptionally good for school and college wear.

## GREY SUEDES ARE ASKED FOR SHOES

A designer tells us that, due to the popularity of suits and sport-togs, grey suede shoes are being called for, and he has given special orders to meet this early demand. There is also a new skin with kid toe and foxing; although the big favorites for street and afternoon wear are as usual, the one-strap, T-strap and opera pump.

Among the new designs by I. Miller are black shoes with fascinating little insets of snakeskin, and where this house showed tan and beige-toned reptile leathers for summer, the skins now take on deeper hues, accenting browns of fall. The vogue of suits, we are told, is responsible for the tailored combination of two leathers. A number of models are also made entirely of lizard and snake skin in the deeper shades. Evening shoes of metallic cord are shown as features for the coming season.

## Yellow Cast is Seen for Hose

Instead of the roseate tinge so popular for summer wear, hose for fall feature shades of tan and beige having a slightly yellow cast in keeping with autumn browns. Neutral tones also make their appearance for wear with blacks and grays and winter blues. Naturally the colors tend down the scale of intensity instead of upward. There is little change in styling except in sports hose, where fancy weaves and drop stitch patterns are developed in heavier weights for fall.

## PATTERN OF RUG IS BASIS FOR CHOICE

In rooms where the carpeting is patterned in definite colors and is of insistent design, it is most important to consider this large area before adding other decorations.

The figured rug always presents a problem, and is best handled by using in connection with it in plain draperies or self-figured materials that complement an important color in the rug. The slipcovers of upholstering of chairs which stand on the rug should also be chosen with this point in mind. We would not use gay flowered

chairs, for example, in a room where the rug was patterned in all-over design in many colors. This would lead to confusion, distraction, whereas the steady influence of plain colored draperies and relatively plain upholstering would give both balance and weight to the room.

Often a good effect is had by the combination of a patterned rug, plain curtains and upholstering in an unobtrusive conventional design cast upon a grand color-harmonious with both carpet and curtains.

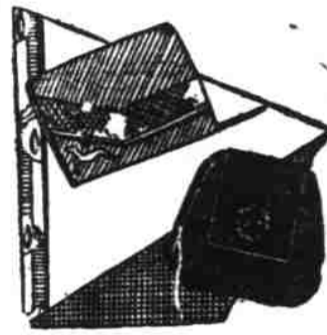
## Walking Sticks Popular for One Who Would Excel

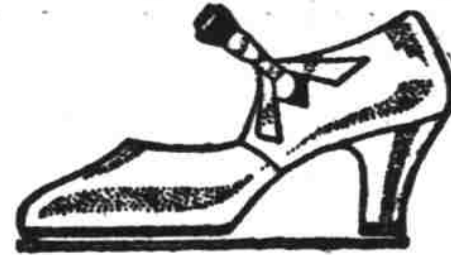

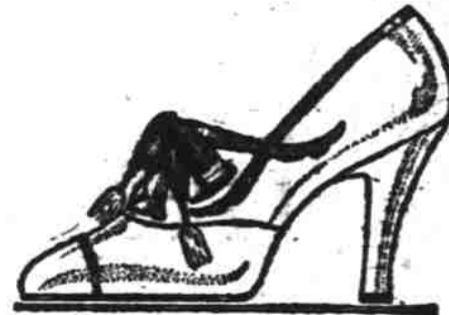
