as to the circumstances and details of the bombing," he said. "I do not believe the supposed confession was ever made."

Superior Judge Franklin Griffin, who presided at Mooney's trial and since has joined those seeking his freedom, recommended immediate investigation of the alleged confession.

"No one so far as I know, has had any idea who set off the bomb," he explained, "no investigation ever went beyond Mooney and the others arrested with him. If any truth is found in Smith's confession it might serve the additional purpose of convincing those people who are still reluctant to believe Mooney innocent."

Good milk is graded by the inspector on two chief things, first, fat content, and second, bacterial count. Aside from these factors, cleanliness, other solids besides fat and keeping quality are also reckoned with in grading milk.

ore throat and diphtheria. The average bacterial count in Marion county has been 7,500 per cubic centimeter. In fact, the county has kept within this figure regularly since inspections were started. The average bacterial count for raw milk has been 16,000 this year as compared with 19,500 last year.

LA FOLLETT FOUND GUILTY BY JURORS

PORTLAND, Ore., Nov. 9—(AP)—A verdict of guilty was returned in the case of Charles LaFollett, Washington county legislator, charged with non-support, by a jury in Judge Stevenson's court today.

LaFollett was accused in the indictment of failing to provide for his estranged wife, Mary, and four children who have been living with her in this city since March. Judge Stevenson set Tuesday for sentence. He also allowed defense attorneys ten days in which to file a motion for a new trial.
