FRANKFORT, III.-(AP)-Sidetracking lightning on electric lines appears to be just around the cor-

Where four or five power lines now are maintained between important cities because of the menace of lightning, the sidetracking plans would have one line sufficient.

Part of the research pointing toward this switching of the wild element from the summer sky is done in an odd appearing little house here, surrounded by a high mesh fence because of its perils to life, and hedged about and above by a seemingly, nonsensical riss-cross of wires. Its doors and rindows are labeled "Danger."

graph, an instrument that combines the sensitivity of electrical recording, the speed of electrons and photographic plates to record the surges of power passing over the lines when lightning strikes, With it the engineers know the power of the element they will have to divert to keep their lines

from being burned up by the chance strokes. It will require time to figure out methods and apparatus to make the switch for a bearable expense, possibly several years, but the scientific men expect to succeed.
