#### Strong Selling Resistance **Encountered** on Wall Street Tuesday

NEW YORK, Jan. 28-(AP)-Strong selling resistance developed in the stock market today when efforts were made to extend the recent recovery, and prices generally closed lower. The decline was not associated with any development in the day's news and was in the nature of a technical correction of a temporarily overbought position. Operators for the advance succeeded in pushing up a number of issues. some of the gains in which ran from 2 to 6 points, Trading showed a moderate decline in volume, the day's sales falling just short of 3,000,000 shares.

Wall street was treated to a number of constructive market developments during the day. Overnight came the weekly federal reserve condition report showing a further shrinkage of \$120,000,000 in security loans by reporting member banks, the total of which is still over seven billion dollars. Around midday came President Hoover's statement of a further gain in employment figures.

After the close of the market, the United States steel corporation issued its report showing earnings of \$21.18 a share for 1929, including a year end credit adjustment of \$9,972,351, without which the earnings would have been \$19.96 a share. Wall street estimates had ranged from \$18 to \$19 a share. The Jones & Loughlin and Inland Steel companies also made public excellent earnings reports, the annual divdend on the common stock of the latter being increased from \$3.50


