Spring Valley

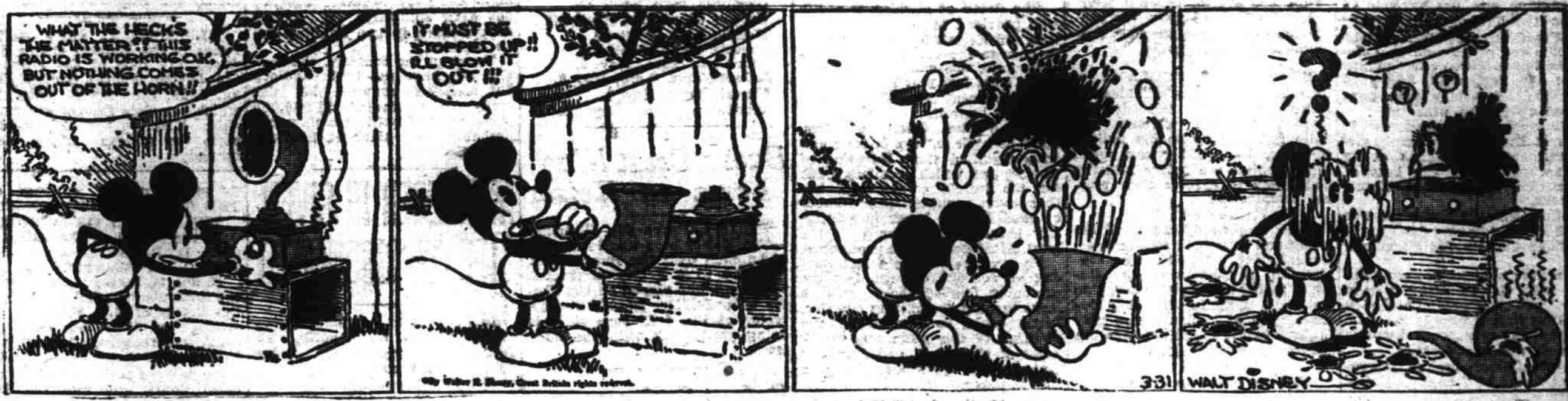
