## FRIENDS BACK U. S. DRY LAW

Yearly Meeting Commends Canada For Outlawing Liquor Export

NEWBERG, Or., June 13. — (Special) — The annual report of the prohibition department, presented by W. H. Heacock of Portland, superintendent of the department, aroused Oregon yearly meeting of Friends church, now in its 38th annual session, to a high pitch of interest and enthusiasm. Mr. Heacock followed his report, which showed commendable activity on the part of Friends, with stirring address, at the close of which the yearly meeting adopted enthusiastically a proposal to send a message of commendation to the government of Canada because of the action of that country in outlawing the exportation of liquor to America. An official protest was lodged against the cigarette advertising now in progress, in periodicals, billboards, and by radio.

An even more vigorous protest was lodged against the recent publicity given to an article calling on the citizens of the United States to violate the 18th amendment. This appeal was voiced in these words: "In every way possible flaunt your defiance of the 18th amendment. Render it inoperative, ignore it, abrogate it, wipe it out. While it stands there let it be disobeyed." The yearly meeting authorized a vigorous protest against such an attitude as this sent to the president of the United States and the attorney general.

Meeting Satisfactory On Elliott's Death. Scarcely less enthusiastic than the greeting given the report of the prohibition department was that which followed the presentation of the report of the bible school department by its superintendent, Esther Gully of Springfield, the report on teacher training by Lyla Miles Dann of Corvallis, and the address given by B. D. Randle, a missionary of the American Sunday school union for southern Oregon. His appeal for belief in the bible and for its use in carrying on the work of God met a hearty response from the yearly meeting.

The yearly meeting was addressed by the news of the death of Frank A. Elliott of Salem, state forester and husband of Marguerite P. Elliott, for 25 years recording clerk of the yearly meeting. The whole congregation stood in silence when the news of this death was received, and then Chester A. Hadley of Portland offered a prayer in which the congregation joined.

On the unanimous recommendation of the evangelistic and church extension committee, Chester A. Hadley, pastor of the First Friends church of Portland was chosen yearly meeting superintendent, following the annual report of this department, made by Edgar P. Sims of Salem, president of the board, who gave an address following the report, "The Good Soldier of Jesus Christ."
