A number of counties in Oregon which failed to include in their budgets mency for the purchase of new Oregon law codes which will be ready for distribution July 1, may have to curtail their orders or do without the codes altogeth-

The law provides that the secretary of state shall furnish to each county clerk, at the expense of his county, a sufficient number of codes to supply one to each county judge, sheriff, assessor, treasurer, recorder, school superintendent and justice of the peace. The new code is in four volumes and the price is \$35.


