COME INTO THE KITCHEN

"Most Excellent Recipes."
"And if you would promise to read a little cookery book which I would send you, it would be excellent for both of us."
So said young David Copperfield to Dora—oh, many years ago! We could say lots of things about how it might apply to present-day swains and their sweethearts, about loveless potato salad and love flying out the window, and how maybe peace and happiness would linger longer if "she would promise to read a little cookery book which he would send her!"

But this time we think we'll omit our philosophizing and give some recipes which may prove excellent for both of you!

Tamale Loaf
1 cup hamburger or ground meat
2 eggs
1 can corn (small)
1/2 cup milk

1 cup yellow cornmeal
1/2 cup rice olives—sliced
1/2 cup canned tomatoes
1 tablespoon chili powder
1 clove minced garlic
1 teaspoon salt
1/4 teaspoon pepper

Mix together all ingredients. Shape in loaf in casserole that has been greased with bacon drippings or butter. Bake at 350 degrees for about 40 minutes. Serve hot with the following sauce.

Melt 1 or 2 tablespoons bacon drippings or oil, and add flour (1 tablespoon to a cup of liquid,) minced garlic, tomato juice and Spanish pepper to taste. Cook until fairly thick.

Tapoca Monkey
Cook slowly in two tablespoons butter, one minced green pepper and one small onion, chopped fine.

Heat 3-4 cup canned corn and 1 cup steamed tomatoes in boiler. Add two tablespoons tapoca, 1 1/2 cups American cheese cut in small pieces, the onions and green pepper, 1-16 teaspoon pepper, a dash of paprika and 1/2 teaspoon salt. Cook 15 minutes, stirring frequently. Serve at once on toast or crackers.

Noodles and Ham au Gratin. (What to do with that leftover ham.)

2 cups cooked noodles
2-3 cup grated cheese
2 cups cooked ham chopped
2 cups thin white sauce

Put layer of noodles in greased casserole. Add layer of ham and well seasoned white sauce and sprinkle with cheese. Repeat. Sprinkle cheese on top. Bake in moderate oven (350 degrees) for about 30 minutes.

Banana Cream Pie
3 bananas
2 cups milk
2 eggs separated
1/2 cup sugar or more
4 tablespoons flour or 2 of cornstarch.

1/2 teaspoon vanilla
1 teaspoon butter
Add flour mixed with a little cold water or milk to the hot milk in a double boiler. Cook until fairly thick. Add egg yolks, sugar and salt mixed together. Cook about three minutes. Remove from range and add vanilla.

Slice bananas, thin in baked pie shell. Pour over them the hot custard. Cover with meringue made from the two egg whites and two tablespoons flour. Brown in slow oven 300 degrees for about 15 minutes.

The whole eggs may be used in the custard and whipped cream used on top.

Cocunut Cream Pie
Add 1 cup cocunut to above custard mixture when cooked. Omitting bananas, pour custard in cooked pie shell. Cover with meringue and cocunut. Brown in 300 degree oven for 10 or 15 minutes.
