## CANTALOUPE WEAK AND QUALITY POOR

Yakima cantaloupes are very weak, with liberal receipts, and generally poor to ordinary quality. A few good Yakimas are present, but this stock is in generally poor repute now. Little more than freight charges are being realized on some arrivals. Fine quality Dillard cantaloupes continue to move readily at \$2.50 to \$2.75 per standard crate.

Movement of cantaloupes from the Dillard-Roseburg district is increasing, but active demand from Portland and other Oregon points is taking the entire production thus far by motor truck without the necessity of loading any cars yet.

Tomatoes are having erratic ups and downs. The week closed with the marked very unsettled, but Monday witnessed active demand, and supplies only moderate in volume.

Walla Walla onions are stronger, with the season approaching its end, and no Oregon on the market yet.

Yakima Elberta peaches are more plentiful now, and will approach the season's peak in a few days. Willamette Valley peaches are unusually plentiful this year, and quality is excellent.
