COME INTO THE KITCHEN

The Lure of Autumn.

Whir of homing bird wings, the rustle of wind in the trees, great golden chrysanthemums and rugged asters of purple and white, a glimpse of gold in the pumpkin vines, gay leaves fluttering down to crinkle merrily against hurrying heels, blue skies—a tang to the air!—Why poets sigh over melancholy days is quite beyond our ken—when its autumn!

Festivities renewed—we haul out the doughnut kettle to bring out puffy mysteries of autumn brown—cranberries sand at quivering attention, pumpkin and squash find themselves in a crisp pie crust bed—the noble turn loses his dignity in a frightened sort of run.

Autumn entertaining is the easiest of all. Fruit for a centerpiece—tall golden candles in low candle holders on a crash or gay linen table runner, the gorgeous colors of fall vegetables blending into the colorful plan of things—Nature herself is with the autumn hostess.

Hallowe'en colors of yellow and black with black paper witches, goblins and cats, the yellow of jack-o-lantern faces and the glow of candlelight—give another variation to entertaining.

At bridge teas may appear Jack-o-lantern sandwiches—two rounds of brown bread put together with cheese and pimento filling, features carved on the top slice with the aid of a sharp knife and a small thimble. Crusty graham or bran muffins with bits of dates and raisins and served with orange preserves is something different.

Ripe olives, oranges, various fruits, or vegetables in a salad

adds to the menu.

Tea, coffee, or hot chocolate—a marshmallow with chocolate features drawn on it—float—any of these may be served.

Desserts are many and varied. Why not orange ice with goblin cakes—tiny chocolate cakes iced with a butter frosting to which has been added a bit of yolk of

egg or orange juice and rind and features of raisins to give the season's touch?

White frosting with chocolate cobwebs, a tiny candle atop, and a little black cat at its side—transforms a little cup cake into a "cup cake of fortune"—if tiny sterilized symbols—rings, coins, thimbles and the like wrapped in waxed paper have been baked inside.

Gingerbread, topped with a cloud of whipped cream finds high favor with "club sisters," as does orange bavarian cream and slices of devil cake.

Autumn luncheons and dinners

are hearty and colorful. Fruit cocktails, canapes, bouillon or vegetable cream soups start the meal just right.

The main course may be meat or vegetable croquettes crowned to a turn in deep fat or baked in a quick oven, crusty meat, chicken or squab pies, roast meat or fowl. With them may be served a tiny mold or square of cranberry jelly, sweet potatoes or squash well-seasoned and mashed to a golden fluffiness. Baked or sliced tomatoes, brussel sprouts, ripe olives, a slice or two of carrots or beets—these lend the touch of color autumn demands

and a zest to the appetite. Vegetables or fruits molded in gelatin and served on a bed of crisp lettuce leaves with mayonnaise and tiny nut or brown bread sandwiches provide another delicious course.

The type of dessert will depend upon the preceding courses. If they have been light—a heavy dessert, such as steamed puddings or rich frozen desserts may be used. Ices and sherberts with tiny assorted cakes or a slice of good home-made cake along with mints and coffee, black—pat its finishing touches to the feast.
