Jenks Tells Horticulture Group Oregon Product Is ne win East

Advirtising that will put the Oregon prune before the world is the greatest need of the prune industry today, W. T. Jenks of Salem, president of the Northwest Dried Fruit association. told members of the Oregon Horticultural society gathered at Eugene this week.

The only prune known to the majority of the consumers, Mr. Jenks said, is the California prune, and most of the fruit produced in this state is sold as California grown.

Mr. Jenks told of noting in a grocery store in eastern Canada boxes of prunes labeled by an Oregon packing plant, but which were marked California prunes. He asked the merchant about that, he said, and the groceryman replied: 'Well, you see, Oregon is a part of California." Acid Prune Adwantage

The large and slightly acid Italian prunes which are produced almost-exclusively in Oremost distinctive of the varieties grown in this state, and these are the ones he believes should be extensively advertised. There is no finer prune grown, he said. than the Oregon Italian, and it has proved very popular with consumers who have become familiar with it.

One of the greatest problems faced by the prune industry in Oregon, Mr. Jenks said, is the irregularities of production. In the northwest in 1928, the lowest of recent years, there were only about 12,000,000 pounds produced, he said. In 1929 the yield came to 125,000,000 and in 1930 it fell again to 20,000,000.

Irregularities Cause Trouble The association is able to handie large quantities of good quality prunes, the speaker stated. and to obtain fair prices for them, but in lean years, such as 1928, it is unable to supply markets which were built up in previous years.
