

LEGION CLEARS UP \$1600 ON NOV. 11

Seeking to bring to Oregon the 1932 national convention of the American Legion, members of Salem Post No. 9 last night passed a resolution supporting the state organization in its efforts to that end. The convention would be held in Portland.

The post decided to stage a benefit boxing card at the armory December 17. Proceeds will be used for the post and the auxiliary for relief purposes only.

Other business at this regular meeting included the Armistice Day committee's report to the effect that the Legion cleared \$1600 in its activities staged on that day; announcement that all members will be required to show their 1931 membership card to gain admittance to the next meeting, December 9.

O. P. West, boy scout executive for this district, spoke interestingly to the group concerning the scout movement in Salem and seeking the Legion's backing for the moving picture of scout activities taken at the international convention in England last summer which will be shown at a local theatre soon.

The quartermaster was instructed to investigate what could be done to improve the appearance of the Legion sign on the Pacific highway at the south city limits.
