**Wild Rice Filling for Roast Duck**  
 1/2 pound wild rice  
 4 tablespoons chopped onions  
 1-2 cup dried celery  
 1 egg, beaten  
 1/4 teaspoon salt  
 1/4 teaspoon paprika  
 1/4 teaspoon sage  
 1 cup warm water  
 1-2 cup butter, melted  
 Thoroughly wash the rice. Soak over night in the warm water and in the morning add rest of ingredients and stuff fowl.

**Relish Dressing**  
 (For head lettuce or tomato salad)  
 1/2 cup stiff mayonnaise  
 2 tablespoons horseradish  
 2 tablespoons chili sauce  
 2 tablespoons chopped sweet pickle relish  
 2 tablespoons catsup  
 2 Mix and chill the ingredients.  
**Ambrosia Cream Pie**  
 1 unbaked pie shell  
 1 cup cream (sweet)  
 1/2 cup sugar  
 1 teaspoon vanilla  
 1/4 teaspoon nutmeg  
 1-2 teaspoon salt  
 2 tablespoons flour  
 2 egg whites, beaten  
 2 tablespoons light brown sugar  
 1-2 cup pecans  
 Beat the cream 1 minute with a fork. Mix the sugar, salt and flour and add to the cream. Add vanilla, nutmeg and nuts. Beat egg whites and add light brown sugar. Combine cream mixture with egg whites. Pour into the pie shell and bake 30 minutes in slow oven.
