Suit to Oppose Seattle Recall Move in Court

SEATTLE, May 23—(AP)—Skirmishes over the avowed ille-

gal purchase of furniture for Mayor Edwards' office and contentions by his attorney that recall charges against him are insufficient marked the opening Friday of the "eight taxpayers" suit to block a recall election. Evidence of the alleged illegal purchases of \$10,948 of furniture, supported by a series of ordinances, was introduced at the outset by counsel for the recall movement, over the protest of attorneys for the eight taxpayers.
