Was Lazy Man's Paradise Up to Magellan's Visit Back in 1521

WASHINGTON (AP)-The ) land of Guam, which is to be abandoned by the navy as a military post, was a lazy man's paradise until starving sailers on one of Magellan's high pooped ships sighted it in March, 1521. Magellan's men got provisions there and found a welcome change from a previous diet composed chiefly of rats. But Guam was never the same afterwards. A clash occurred. Seven or eight

natives were killed and 40 or 50 of their thatch houses burned. The explorers said the inhabitants had stolen a boat and they called Guam and the dots of islands about it, the Ladrones, or Thieves islands. Shortly after Magellan sailed

away, missionaries arrived to find the natives leading a carefree existence.

The Spanish ewned the island, but occasionally there were unwelcome visitations by wandering


