

ADVANCE NOTED ON HEAVY HENS

Price as High as 19 Cents, Lights Also up Cent; No Shipping Sales

PORTLAND, June 25—Generally steady to firm trend is reflected in the market for butter. Daily cleanup of offerings is indicated with no change in current values. Undergrades are most plentiful.

There is quite a keen demand for heavy weight hens with bids for over 4 1/2 point weights up to 19c lb. Light weights are generally 11c with a few down to 10c.

There are sufficient offerings of broilers in the live chicken trade to take care of immediate wants. Killers are not operating for shipment because outside prices and demand are not better than here. Most bids 17c lb.

While some sales are reported fractionally below, general trading in light weight top quality chickens is at the high price recently established. The same applies to blocker hogs. Lambs are steady.

Easier price situation appears in the market for new potatoes with increasing local offerings as well as low priced competition from the Shafter, Cal. district. Sales here about 1/4 c lb. lower.

With the exception of salmon, which remains more or less scarce; liberally increased supplies of fresh fish are reported by the local trade as a result of the cessation of the recent storm. Plenty of crabs.

Notes of wholesale trading: Cantaloupe prices still hardening in the south. Green and wax beans are steady to firm.

Demand for hothouse cucumbers exceeds the supply. Good call for outdoor stuff from The Dalles. Hothouse tomatoes cleaning up well up to 15c lb.

Watermelons are lower again; general top 2 1/4 c lb. Casabas and honey dew melons remain slow.

Cherry demand is better for good fruit. Peas are steady to firm with general top.

Continued rains are causing heavy damage to some crops, particularly hay and certain varieties of black berries. The loganberry crop has been materially benefited as fitted as the late grain crop.

Loss to Etterberg strawberry growers was heavy due to continued rain during the past week. Late cherries may be damaged if the rain continues and in many places the growers lost as high as 90 per cent of the Royal Ann and black cherry crop.

Prunes which promise to be a good crop this year are being benefitted by the rain and growers are hopeful of a fair market. Hops are continuing to be threatened by downy mildew which is made much worse by cool damp weather. Growers report that damage has not been extensive so far but that the mildew has appeared in several yards.

Contract Firm Entitled to no Interest, Held

The state has no authority to pay interest on a claim of \$19,240, which was allowed the United Contracting company by an arbitration board, following a dispute with the state highway commission, according to an opinion handed down by Attorney General VanWinkle.

The claim originally was \$26,744.98, with interest amounting to \$7500. The opinion was requested by Hal E. Hoss, secretary of state.

WHEAT MOVING, PRICES DO FLOP DEMAND FOR BERRIES IS KEENER

Receipts Heavy, Stock Advances Fail to Reflect now

CHICAGO, June 25—(AP)—Dominated by increasing movement of the new 1931 crop out of the harvest fields in the big producing states, wheat prices underwent material setbacks today. Receipts of new wheat at all markets totaled 67 cars, including 25 cars at Chicago.

Despite fresh upturns of securities, speculative buyers backed away from wheat offerings, and paid persistent stress on continued lack of any definite assurance that government sponsored old crop domestic wheat holdings would be kept off the market.

Wheat closed unsettled 7-8-1-3-8 cents lower, corn 1/4 off to 1-3 up, oats unchanged to 1-3-1/4 advance.
