BLUEBERRY COBBLER
Menu for Dinner
Sliced Roast Beef
Hashed Browned Potatoes
Corn on the Cob
Dread Current Jam
Cold Slaw
Blueberry Cobbler
Coffee

Current Jam
6 cups currants
3 cups water
3 cups sugar
1 teaspoon cinnamon
1/4 teaspoon salt
Wash currants and remove from stems. Add water and color. Cook slowly until very soft. Add the rest of the ingredients and cook until mixture thickens. Stir frequently.

Cold Slaw
2 egg yolks (or 1 egg)
5 tablespoons flour
1 teaspoon salt
1/4 teaspoon dry mustard
1/4 teaspoon paprika
1/2 cup vinegar
1-2 cup water
2 tablespoons cream
3 cups chopped or shredded cabbage
Beat egg yolks and add flour and sugar. Mix well. Add seasonings, vinegar and water. Cook slowly and stir constantly, until sauce thickens. Cool. Add cream and beat two minutes. Add cabbage and serve.

Blueberry Cobbler
2 cups flour
3 teaspoons baking powder
1/4 teaspoon salt
1/2 cup milk
Mix flour, baking powder and salt. Cut in fat with a knife. Add milk and when soft dough forms pat it out to fit over top of berry mixture.

Berry Mixture
1 quart blueberries
1 cup sugar
2 tablespoons flour
2 tablespoons lemon juice
1/4 teaspoon cinnamon
2 tablespoons water
2 tablespoons butter
Carefully wash berries. Add

flour and sugar. Add the rest of the ingredients. Pour into shallow, buttered dish. Cover with dough and bake 25 minutes.

Salad Dressing
(For fruit salads)
4 egg yolks
1/2 cup water
2 tablespoons sugar
2 tablespoons flour
1/2 cup vinegar
1/4 teaspoon dry mustard
1/4 cup water
2 tablespoons cream
Beat egg yolks and add dry ingredients. Mix well and add vinegar and water. Cook in double boiler until thick and creamy. Stir frequently. When done, beat two minutes and cool. Add cream. Mix well and chill.

Apricot Ice
3 cups sugar
3 cups water
2 cups crushed apricots
2-3 cup lemon juice
1 cup orange juice
2 egg whites, beaten
Boil sugar and water 2 minutes. Cool and add all the rest of the ingredients. Freeze until still. Serve in glass cups.

Cake
1-3 cup fat
1 cup sugar
2-3 cup cold water
1/2 teaspoon vanilla
2 eggs
1/4 teaspoon salt
1/2 cups pastry flour
2 cups baking powder
Cream fat and sugar. Add rest of the ingredients and beat for 3 minutes. Bake in 2 layers. Add filling.

Filling
1/4 cup sugar
1/2 teaspoon salt
2 tablespoons flour
3 tablespoons lemon juice

2 tablespoons grated rind
1/4 cup water
1 egg
1 tablespoon butter
Blend sugar and flour. Add rest of ingredients. Cook until creamy. Stir constantly. Cool. Use as filling between cake layers. Frost with any desired white icing.

Buttered Spinach
2 pounds spinach
1/2 cup water
1/2 cup butter
1/4 teaspoon paprika
2 tablespoons butter
Thoroughly wash spinach and break off and discard roots. Add water and boil gently 20 minutes. Drain and reserve stock for soup. Add rest of ingredients. Chop with knife and heat until very hot. Serve at once. Garnish with hard-cooked egg slices.

Bran Muffins
2 1/2 cups flour
2 cups bran
1-2 cup sugar
1 teaspoon soda
2 teaspoons baking powder
1/2 teaspoon salt
1/2 cup molasses
2 eggs
2 cups milk
4 tablespoons fat, melted
Mix ingredients. Beat two minutes. Half fill greased muffin pans and bake 15 minutes in moderate oven.

Rice Pudding
4 egg yolks
2 1/2 cups milk
1/2 teaspoon vanilla
1/4 cup sugar
1-2 cup rice
2 tablespoons butter
Beat egg yolks and add rest of

ingredients. Mix well. Pour in buttered baking dish. Set in pan of hot water and bake 35 minutes in slow oven.

1 teaspoon salt

1 cup sugar
2 tablespoons flour
2 tablespoons lemon juice
2 tablespoons orange juice
2 tablespoons grated orange rind
2 tablespoons grated lemon rind
1-2 teaspoon salt
2 egg whites, beaten
Beat yolks and add flour and
