1 teaspoon vanilla  
1/2 teaspoon salt  
1 cup boiled rice

Savory Sliced Tomato Salad  
8 slices tomato  
1-8 cup Roquefort cheese  
16 slices cucumbers  
2 tablespoons green peppers  
1/2 cup diced celery  
2 tablespoons onions  
1/2 teaspoon salt  
Chill ingredients. Arrange tomatoes on crisp lettuce. Spread with cheese and add rest of ingredients. Top with French dressing and serve.

French Dressing  
1 teaspoon salt  
1 teaspoon paprika  
1/2 teaspoon dry mustard  
1/2 teaspoon celery salt  
1/2 teaspoon chopped onion  
2 tablespoons sugar  
2 tablespoons lemon juice  
1 cup salad oil  
Mix all ingredients in bottle. Cork tightly and shake two minutes. Chill. Shake well when ready to use.

Sunshine Surprise Dessert  
6 egg yolks  
1 teaspoon lemon extract  
1 teaspoon almond extract  
1/2 teaspoon salt  
1 cup sugar  
6 egg whites, beaten  
1 cup pastry flour  
2 1/2 tablespoons grated orange rind  
Beat egg yolks and extracts. Add salt. Sift sugar four times. Slowly add to egg yolks. Beat well. Add egg whites and flour, sifted four times. Mix lightly. Add rest of ingredients. Bake hour in deep pan in slow oven. Cut cake into two inch circles and top with generous portions of pineapple sherbet. Garnish with bits of candied pineapple and red cherries.
