AS ARMY TRIED TO SINK SHIP





These three pictures tell the story of the bombing of the transport Mt. Shasta by ten U. S. Army bombing planes from Langley Field Va. The Army fliers, although they scored two direct hits, failed to sink the craft while the Navy is reported to have snickered and the Coast Guard actually sank the transport by gunfire.
