Schedules for meetings of the 29 student organizations at the enior high school probably will be completed by next Wednesday. R. W. Tavenner, assistant principal, announced yesterday. As only two home room periods are available each week for the meetings and there are so many organizations, the final schedule will provide for fortnightly instead of

weekly meetings. The matter of the number of activities students may participate in is largely taken care of by the intricacles of the schedule, Tavenner stated. Students attempting to work in too many clubs will find that the meeting dates conflict, so that they must choose a fewer number of activities. All of the organizations are connected either with the affairs of the associated students or with the differ, ent school subjects. Each group selects a faculty advisor. It is maintained that participation in Bids. he extra-curricular activities broadens the student and adds to

his interest in studies. The list of high school organizations includes the student council, senior, juntor and sophomore classes, Girls' League, Latin French and German clubs, Snikpoh dramatic club, Techne Art club, Home Economics club, Science club with the following clubs as branches-Astronomy, Radio, Biology, Chemistry, Physics and Slide Rule; Future Craftsmen of America for the machine and auto shop students, S club for athletics, Girls' Letter club for physical education, Crescendo and Music club, junior chamber of commerce for commercial students, girls glee club, boys glee club, 235.00 girls' league cabinet, Clarion newspaper news staff and business staff, Quill and Scroll for journalistic students, and the Clarion annual staff and business Pontlac staff.

Prune drying in the northwest is virtually all completed at this date, with the exception of a few orchards in the hill lands adjacent to Sheridan and McMinnville, where production is usually the latest in the district. Completion of the drying sea son permits the following brief

review. Total production is less than estimated prior to harvest, due to unusually heavy shrinkage in drying. The crop for drying was characterized this year by a large moisture content, although otherwise of excellent quality. Total production may not exceed 45 million pounds, compared with early estimates of 53-60 million pounds.

Sizes are generally 4 or 5 points smaller than were estimated earlier in the season. Most districts report a prevalence of 40-45s, with a general average of 43-44 dried prunes per pound. 30-35s are almost non-existent in

many districts. Almost no sales were effected by growers until the past few days, due to the concerted action of growers in holding for prices approximately equivalent to exporters' offers for packer stock.

Denton Burdick Forfeits Bail In Drunk Case


