SHINGLE 74 YEARS OLD IS STILL GOOD

A 74-year old cedar shingle exhibited by Senator Sam Brown, Gervais, in a contest sponsored at the state fair by two shingle companies took first prize, \$15. This shingle was laid in 1857 and had been in continuous use until it was removed from the roof to be entered in the contest. Senator Brown says that the old roof on his home is still keeping the rain out.
