FARMERS OFFERED HELPING HAND

In order to help the farmers of Marion and Polk counties meet the general conditions of today by giving them an opportunity to dispose of their farm products regardless of how small or large a quantity they may have the Farmers Public Market at 356 N. Liberty street is offering free rent for the month of December to all farmers who may wish to come in and sell their produce direct to the consumer. Farmers may stay a week, two weeks or the entire month if they wish without a cent of rent.

Any kind of farm products with the exception of fresh meats can be sold through the market, such as apples, prunes, walnuts, filberts, squash, potatoes, winter cabbage, carrots, turnips and other winter vegetables, home-made jam, mince meat, sausage, butter, cottage cheese, candy, smoked meats, eggs, chickens and other poultry.

During this period there will be no restrictions on prices, each farmer being allowed to set his own price. Mr. Gray, the market manager, feels that by adopting this policy for thirty days he is making it possible for the farmer to dispose of his products with no overhead and in his own way to the consumer.

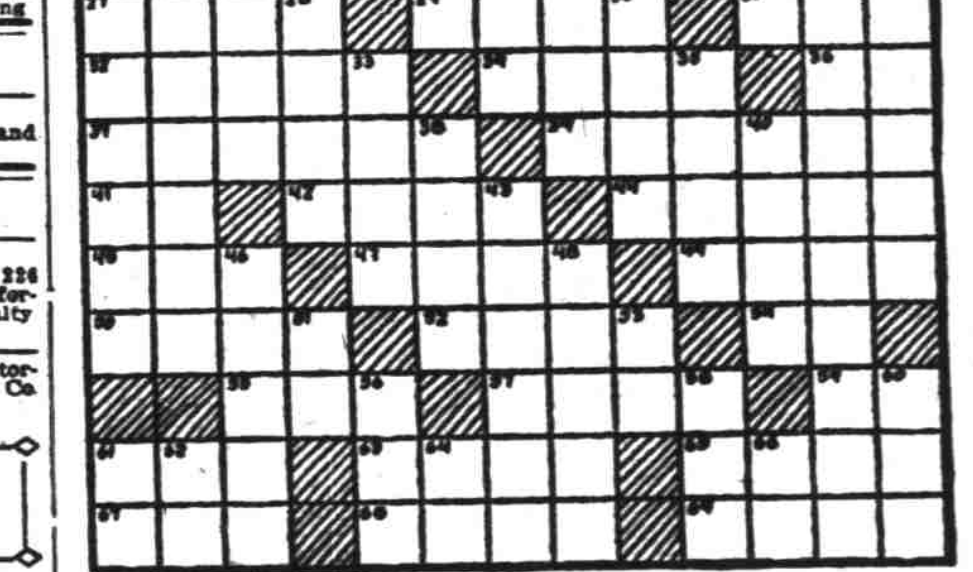
