M'KAY INSTALLED AS CHAMBER HEAD

"The king is dead, long live the king" the chamber of commerce luncheoners might have shouted yesterday noon. Instead they applauded the retiring president, H. R. Crawford, and gave him a vote of thanks; and they applauded likewise Douglas McKay the incoming president.

President Crawford reviewed briefly the experiences of a president of this body. He said that before he went into office he was a bit skeptical of what the chamber accomplished. His experience had shown him not only that the chamber accomplished a tremendous amount of work, much of it not visible to the general public, but that it took a great deal of work and time to put over the various projects which it espouses.

He cited briefly achievements of the past year which included work with the county court to get the North Santiam work pushed along, to get Silver Creek falls area taken over as a state park, work for widening of the Salem-Portland highway. Besides this the chamber has to do a lot in the way of heading off undesirable promotions and exploitations which are constantly coming up.

President McKay introduced his board members. He recited 15 objectives for the year's work, stressing road work, urging sitting aside of Marion Lake and Eight Basin country as a primitive area, etc.
