

### PRaise ACCORDED FIRST PRESIDENT

#### Judge McCamant is Speaker At Methodist Council Dinner Wednesday

In measured phrases of oratory interspersed with a comprehensive factual review of George Washington's life, Judge Wallace McCamant of Portland paid brilliant tribute Wednesday night to the memory of the father of the nation at a Washington's birthday banquet held at the First Methodist church here.

"Washington's firm place endures throughout our contemporary world," said McCamant. "Men's hearts today are brighter and life is larger and finer because of the lasting, continuing influence of this great man, truly first in war, first in peace, and first in the hearts of his countrymen."

Judge McCamant's address which traced Washington's career from birth, early training, pre-revolutionary experience, and wartime service through to his death in 1799, was listened to most attentively by an audience

of 175 townspeople, many of whom were guests for the evening of the Methodist men's council which sponsored the dinner.

Colonel Carl Abrams was toastmaster for the banquet. He introduced Judge George Rossman who in turn introduced Judge McCamant. The meeting was called to order by John H. Carlin who is president of the First Methodist Men's council. Colonel W. D. G. Mercer gave the invocation.

Program numbers included a piano duet by Gretchen Thielson and Carolyn Parker, a trumpet duet by Wesley Rooder and Gus Klumpel, a reading by Lois Wilkes and a song by Elizabeth Ogden.

Justices Campbell, Rand and Rosman of the state supreme court were special guests at the dinner.
