Mrs. Currie told of the trip across the plains by her grandparents and of their spending the winter on the place now operated by J. J. Thompson, Then Mrs. C. R. Riches told the story of George Riches starting from the east with the Geer train, but he was young and impatient and left the train to continue his trip by pack horse, reaching Oregon many months before the train. After working in Oregon City he one day made the trip to what is now the Waldo Hills and at a point where the Fred Knight house now stands he again met the train so in the end all three families settled within two miles of each other. Mrs. C. C. Geer represented the Geer family, telling of Joseph Cory Geer, who made the trip to Oregon with the Barlow train in 1845, two gears previous to the coming of the other families and his own. He was instrumental in organizing the first state fair, which was held in Oregon City in 1854. He was one of those building the territorial government building and was interested in the Oregon railroad. He was also the first Waldo Hills school tecaher and she showed the round black ferrule that he used. He is known as "the father of the pear industry."
