BUT, MY GOOD SIR...

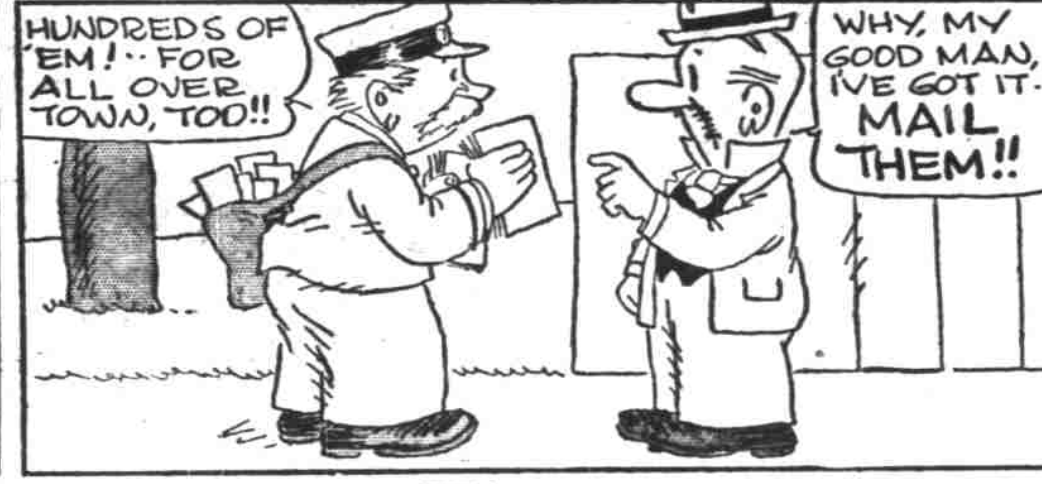

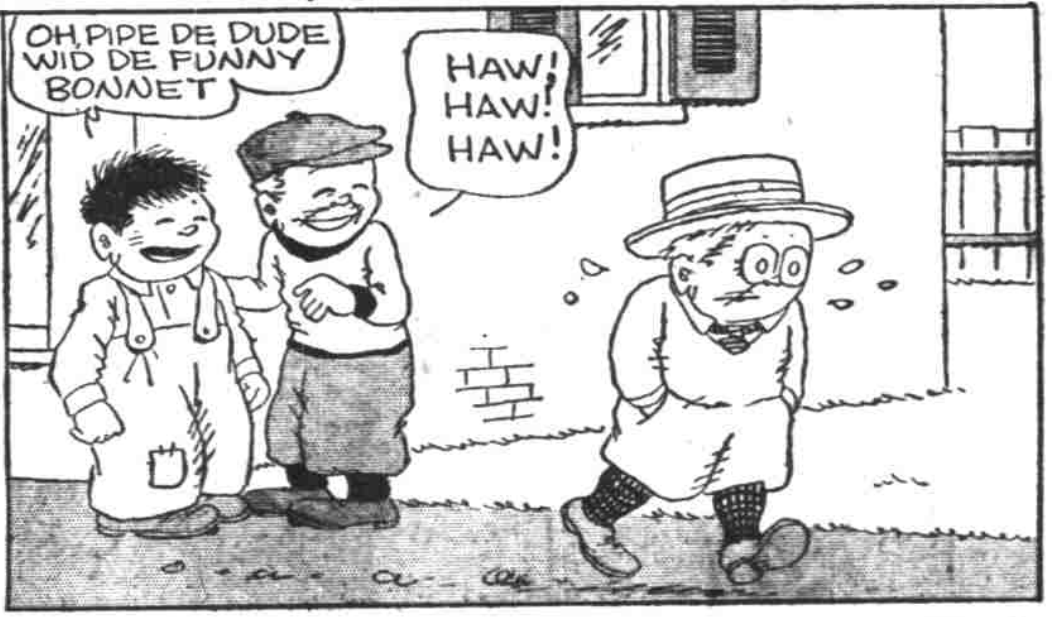
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LOOK, ELMER, ISN'T THIS NICE??

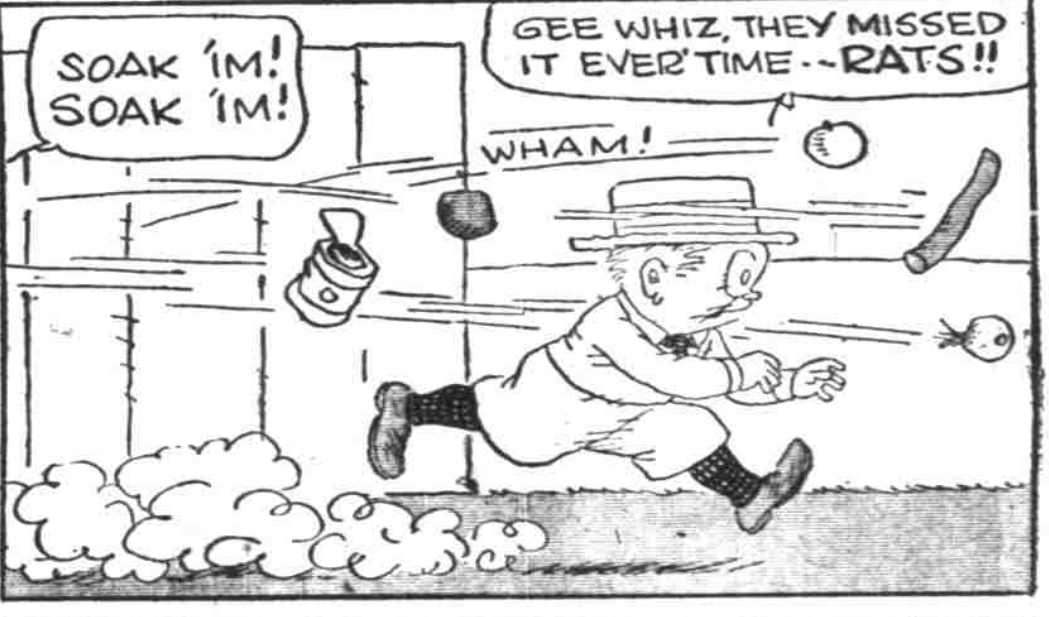
GEE WHIZ, MA, YOU AINT GONNA MAKE ME WEAR THAT, ARE YOU?
