Grains Gain but Then Lose; Shut-down Has Effect

CHICAGO, July 25—(AP)—Notwithstanding that grain values temporarily advanced today despite a shock from efforts at Washington to stop board of trade operations, prices afterward fell.

Concentrated selling that many observers attributed to government-financed agencies proved too heavy a weight to be resisted by speculative demand which had noticeably thinned out.

After a loss of about a cent a bushel wheat closed unsettled, 1-5/8 under Saturday's finish, corn 3-3/4 down, oats unchanged to 3-8 off.

STOCKS GO ABOVE JUNE'S HIGH MARK

By JOHN L. COOLEY NEW YORK, July 25—(AP)—The stock market moved through its early June highs in relatively active trading today, accompanying another mark-up in bond prices.

Speculators for the advance were assisted by brisk short covering in a number of shares, notably by United States Steel, which jumped 5 1/4 points on gossip which the regular quarterly dividend would be declared at tomorrow's board meeting and reports that the company's second quarter financial statement might make a better showing than had been anticipated.

Generally speaking, stocks enjoyed a broad market. Oil's were conspicuously strong, but industrials, rails and utilities moved forward in a manner that bespoke speculative optimism.

There was no official hint as to what the Steel corporation planned to do with its Preferred dividend, but traders still shied from the stock took in all against ordering of the usual pattern.

Steel Common rose 1 1/2, while Bethlehem Common and Preferred gained 1 1/8 and 3 1/8, respectively. American Telephone, Allied Chemical, Eastman, National Biscuit, Consolidated Gas, Liggett & Myers "B," American Tobacco "B," Safeway Stores, Woolworth, U. S. Tobacco, Auburn and Santa Fe made average advances of 2 points. Union Pacific, which is comfortably covering fixed charges in these days of railroad deficits, was up 2 7/8.
