# COSTS OF FOREST PROTECTION LESS Due to Better Weather, is

Statement: Federal Aid is Reduced Expenditures for forest protection of Oregon lands under the jurisdiction of the state forestry

department during the period Jan-

per cent less than during the cor-

Cronemiller, state forester, announced Thursday. These include all the expenditures made by the various associations of the state as well as those made directly out of the state forester's office. Total expenditures for the present year were \$87,722.61, as against \$127,-

178.24 for 1931. Favorable weather conditions were said to have been a contributing factor in reducing the number of forest fires this year. Other savings resulted from salary reductions and the lower costs of supplies and equipment. Cronemiller said it had not been necessary thus far this year to place the full-protection organization in the field.

Wood-Wheaton Motor The state forester was advised Thursday by the United States forest service that the Clarke-Mc-Nary allotment to Oregon for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1933, is \$91,488. This is a reduction of \$6904 when compared with last






