VICTIMIZED BY BOGUS COPS



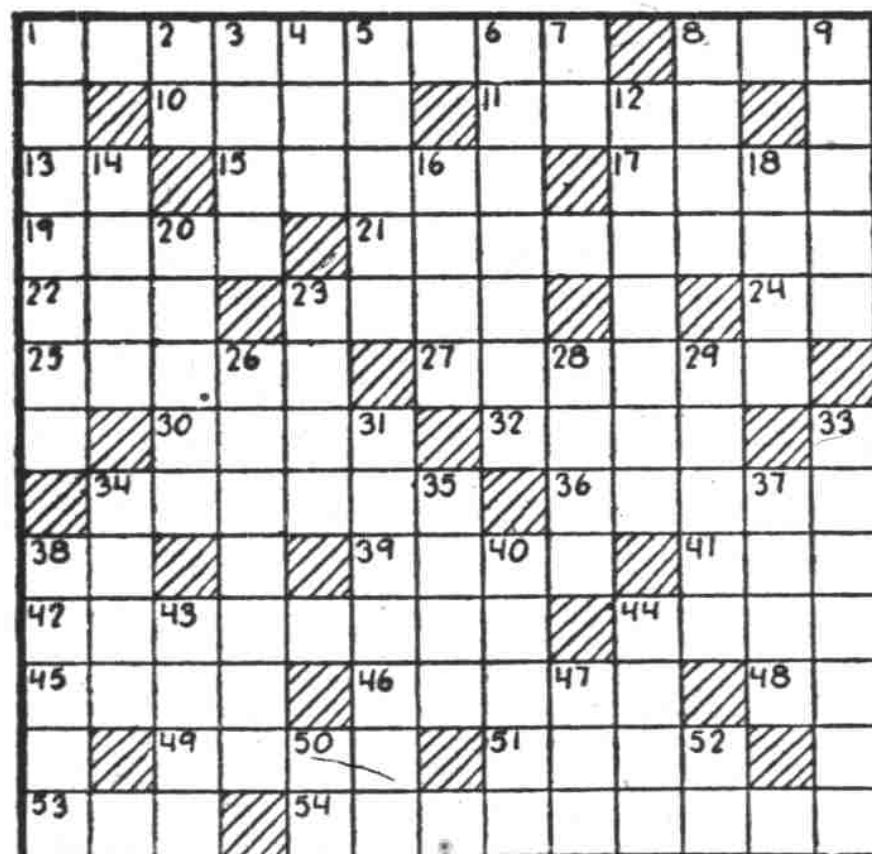

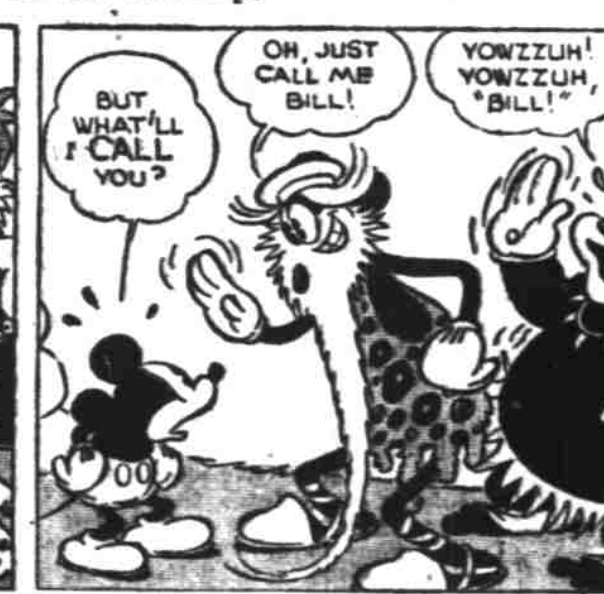
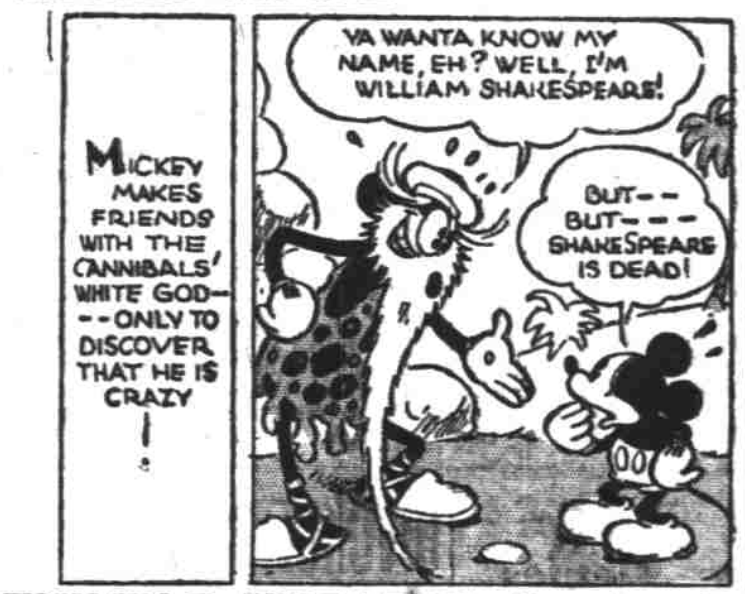
