The nine and a half cents a pound on the marachino product, or cherries candied, crystallized, or glazed, or preserved in any manner, with an additional charge of 40 per cent. ad valorem, is of course for the benefit of the marachino manufacturers. It is enough. And Pacific coast growers are not now directly much interested. Indirectly, however, they are concerned, and they will not be found making any complaint, so long as the eastern manufacturers are prevented from success in their pigsticker attitude—the attitude they have exhibited in asking for themselves full protection, while fighting a reasonable rate for the growers.
