 the Indian office, of which he was the official messenger, knew little of anything, but in addition to his Indian duties his activities were numerous and varied, as I think are quite well described by you in the quotation from your article by Mr. Hendricks, in The Statesman; but I never knew that he was so conscientious as to be so good to the good people of Salem on the grounds of immorality, but on the contrary I know that he was trusted implicitly by many good and prominent people with business and intimate personal matters.

"As to his carrying his arm in a sling, I cannot remember his doing so, and yet at times he I think are quite well described by you in the quotation from your article by Mr. Hendricks, in The Statesman; but I never knew that he was so conscientious as to be so good to the good people of Salem on the grounds of immorality, but on the contrary I know that he was trusted implicitly by many good and prominent people with business and intimate personal matters.

"Late on the evening of Nov. 28, 1872, the day before the outbreak, I was talking with Supt. Odeneal (T. B. Odeneal) a couple of hundred yards east of the Linkville hotel, yet on horseback, walking out to meet the Indian trails from Yainax, and by the way, my station on Sprague river, supposing I was coming to attend another council with Captain Jack, leader of the renegade band of Modocs on the reservation. Odeneal had seen me coming and had walked out to meet me, to explain that Jack had spurned the messenger he had sent to him to arrange for a peace council, and that he (Odeneal) had called on Col. Green, commander at Fort Klamath, for 50 cavalrymen to compel Jack to go with his band to the reservation, provided that he could not be accomplished by peaceable means—and, that very day, those men were to leave Fort Klamath at noon, and no doubt they were already far on their way, Iva (Ivan D. Applegate) being with them as their guide, and his representative to endeavor to secure a peaceful surrender.
