WALL STREET LEANS TOWARD FIRMNESS

NEW YORK, Dec. 5.—(AP)—Stocks had a teazing toward firmness today.

Transactions totaled 725,219 shares.

Owens Glass, which had been more than 2 points higher, showed an extreme loss of similar size, although the net decline amounted to 1 1/2. Crown Cork & Seal dropped a couple of points. Alcohol stocks were steady, while Coca Cola hopped up 3 1/2 net.

Rails did well while the list was rising. President Storey of Santa Fe indicated his belief that the directors would vote a regular annual dividend on the preferred, although there had been no intimation that any unfavorable action was contemplated. Santa Fe, Union Pacific, New York Central and Southern Pacific closed virtually unchanged.

EGGS DOWN 1c, DRESSED HOGS LOW

Onion Prices Stiffen As Growers Hold; Oranges Fall

EGGS dropped another cent on the local market Monday morning, with the new top 22 cents on extras. Standards bring the farmer .21 cents and mediums, 19 cents. Pullets are quoted at 15 cents.

Hogs dropped 25 cents a hundred yesterday, to top of \$3.50, while other livestock remained unchanged. Dressed hogs are down the lowest in many weeks, to 4 1/2 cents a pound.

Local unloading of a carload of place pack oranges at \$1.50 wholesale will bring the retail price of this grade of navel down to a range of from 10 to 25 cents a dozen within a day or so, it is anticipated. Place pack navel have been quoted from \$2.25 to \$2.50, wholesale.

Onions prices are stiffening, and Lahish growers are holding as many back as possible for expected higher market. Carload lots are quoted at 60 cents, but small lots are still being bought by local merchants at 50 cents a hundred.

California lettuce is coming in strong at \$1.85, wholesale, or five cents a head, retail. There is only a small quantity of local, inferior grade lettuce on the market.
