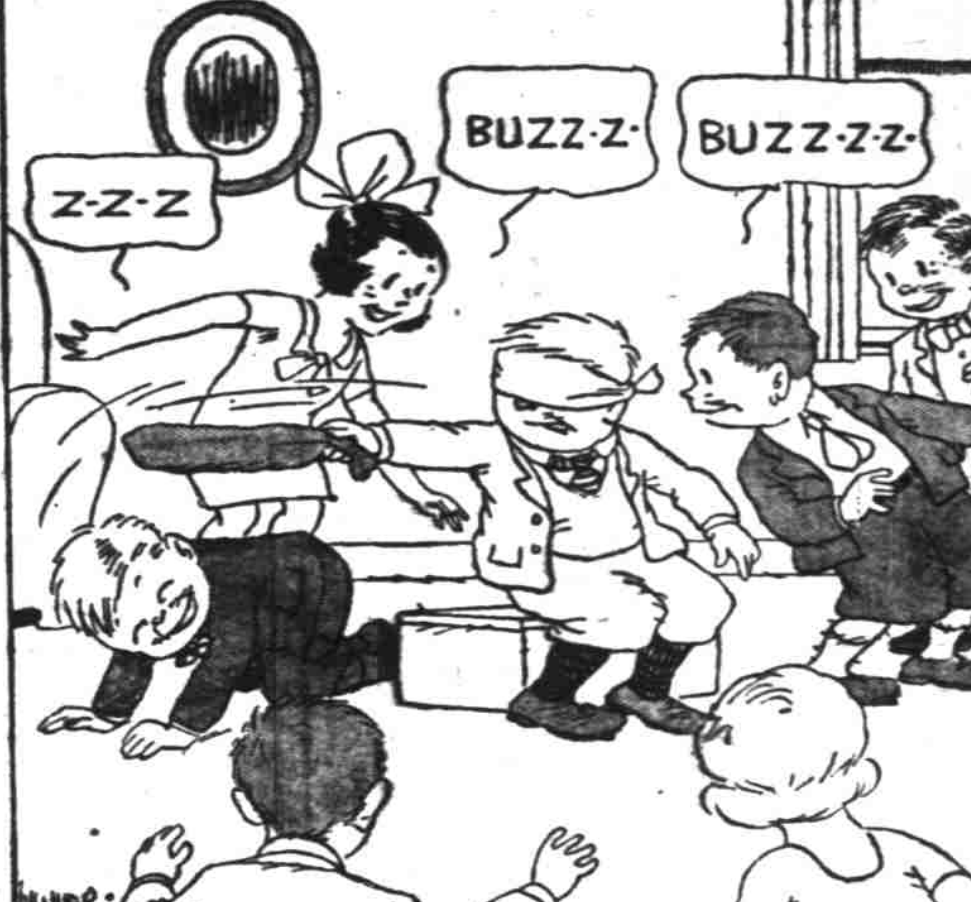

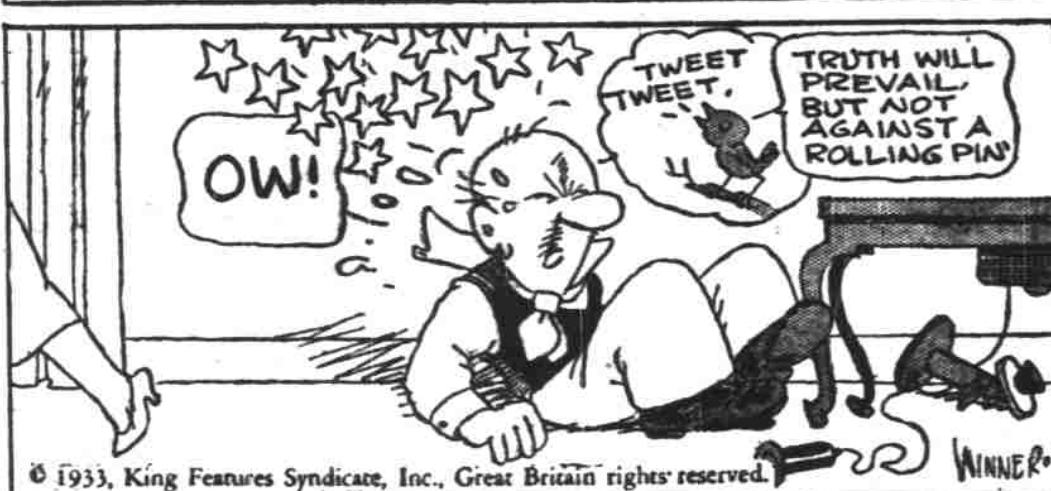


THE ELMER GAME

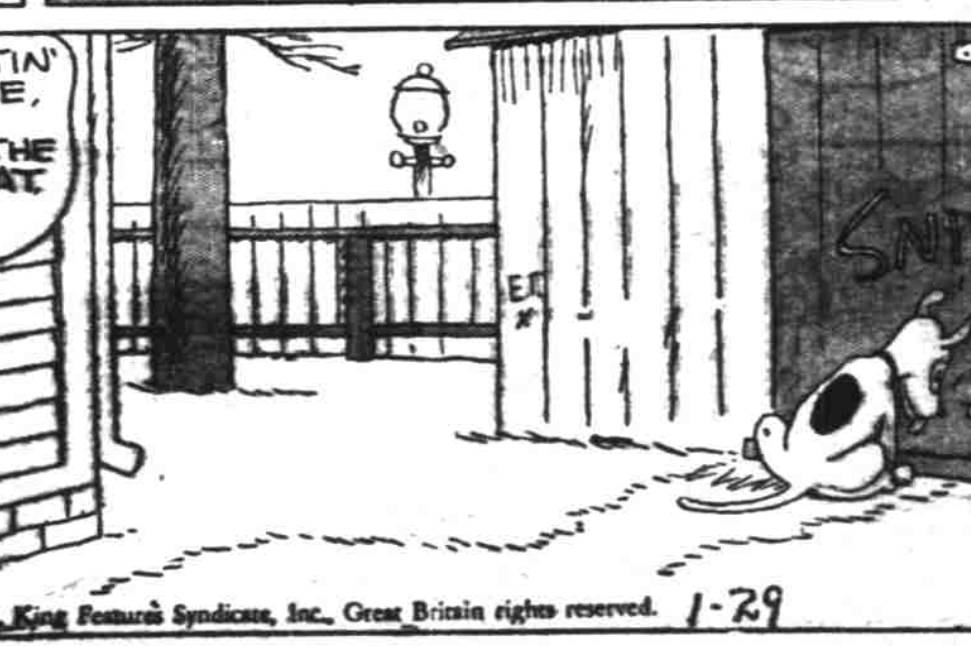
