PORTLAND PRODUCE MART STEADY WHEAT UPTURN SALES BEARISH

Butter is Retaining Strength; Chicken Supplies Scant

PORTLAND, Feb. 18.—(AP)—Market for butter continues its recent showing of strength locally. Outside shippers who have been trying to hold down the price at Portland so they could secure a profit on California business have been unable to retain their hold because of the scant churning.

Demand for butter in the home territory appears sufficient to clean up everything churned here. Butterfat prices were mixed but continue very firm generally.

Market for eggs continues to reflect shaded prices, more or less openly. Few sales were being made at the prices officially listed with outsiders still reported as underselling all competitors.

Very scant supplies of chickens were noted in the live poultry trade. All sorts were moving out into consuming channels at the weekend with prices held intact at the recent slight betterment.

Well held prices were generally showing in the market for country killed meats. Top quality veal and lambs were firmest but there was a good demand for hogs which is cleaning up all arrivals of quality.
