## Salem Markets

Onion Trade Trifle Slower; Turkeys Are Scarce

PORTLAND, March 4—(AP)—Butter trade conditions continued steady and generally without price change either on the produce exchange for cubes or on the open market for both prints and cubes.

Demand for butter was surprisingly good in all directions. All along the Pacific slope conditions were considered very favorable.

There was no change in the price of butterfat for the week-end, a spread of 2c still being shown among various operators.

Chicken prices were being held very firm along the wholesale way for live offerings. This applies to all sorts. There was a good demand for spring ducks and a moderate one for old offerings.

Demand for turkeys continues to exceed the supply locally and the call to the country was not being filled. While there was still a big flock of turks in the country, producers feel that better price may be forced later.
