250 CARLOADS OF ONIONS STILL HELD

LABISH CENTER, March 7.—Another pool of 30 carloads of onions was released by the Labish Onion Growers association Monday noon at a dime increase in price, or 60c a hundred.

Fifteen of the 30 cars were taken by United Brokers, and the remainder by Swank and Hayes.

The buyers were given until noon Monday to take the pool, otherwise the entire lot would have been bought by A. F. Hayes, one of the directors of the association, who was given authority to buy by other directors of the association. Hayes could have disposed of the 30 cars at 60c Saturday had he had authority to do so.

The oriental market appears to be widening, with orders now coming from Shanghai, and the eastern market is opening up. The sales of last week were largely speculative, the onions being sent to New York to be put in cold storage.

It is estimated that about 250 carloads are held in this district.
