EGG PRODUCTION IS BELOW LAST YEAR

Portland Prices Cent Above Year ago; Coast Markets Continue Steady

CORVALLIS, Ore., March 16.—(AP)—Egg prices at Portland a cent above a year ago, coast production off 20 per cent from last year, and total storage holdings in the country about a million cases under March 1, 1932, are some of the highlights of the egg market for the past week, it was shown today in a review by the U. S. D. A. bureau of agricultural economics cooperating with the O. S. C. extension service.

All Pacific coast markets were steady with prices unusually uniform during the week, Portland prices for large Oregon extras being 16 cents. Prices in New York on Pacific coast eggs held steady at 22 1/2 cents though termination of the bank holidays weakened the mixed color market.

Oregon and Washington showed some gain in production but California dropped off nearly as much, so the total gain for the week was less than one per cent. Production now is a fifth under a year ago. Carlot shipments east were 66 for the week compared with 92 a year ago.

Storages of eggs has slowed up considerably because of inability of operators to finance extensive operations. Packers are putting away their surplus receipts, however, so that there was a considerable increase in coast holdings during the week.

The poultry market was generally steady for all classes at Portland, with broilers somewhat scarce. Cold storage holdings in the country are eight million pounds under a year ago and 15,000,000 under the March 1, average.

PORTLAND, March 16.—(AP)—Continued spread of prices in the egg market appears due more to the sale of huge quantities of undergrade in Portland than any other cause.

Rapid increase in the sales of undergrade eggs in Portland has caused huge supplies to roll here from the north inasmuch as this market appears to absorb the inferior grades better than any place along the coast.

Market for butter showed a loss of 1/2 cent in standard and prime first cubes on the produce exchange, a result of the desire of buyers to keep extras at the highest range. Butterfat values were still mixed but a trifle easier in spots.

Market for live chickens was very firm along the wholesale price list. Market continues to show strength for dressed turkeys. Sales of ordinary stock were being made at the price on tops, which probably means an advance of 1c for the latter, if available.

There was a slower trade in country killed calves during the last 24 hours and some carryover was shown. Hogs and lambs as well as mutton continued in call, and at late prices.
