RAILROAD EQUITIES TAKE ON CHEERFUL LOOK

Railroad equities had a rather cheerful appearance. The drop in weekly freight loadings—40,014 cars—was somewhat smaller than had been anticipated in many quarters and although the trend is usually upward at this season, restrictions placed on business by the banking holiday were readily accepted as a plausible reason for the decline.
