A quilt exhibit open to all wom-
en in Salem and Marion county
will be held April 18, 19 and 20,
both afternoon and nights, in the
Knight Memorial church and annexe,
yesterday, it was announced.
The exhibit is sponsored by the primary
teachers of Knight Memorial church
school of which Mrs. E. B. Daugherty
is superintendent and Mrs. Newell
Williams, assistant.

The display has a two-fold pur-
pose: to enable quilters to view
each other's handiwork and to start
a new primary building for the
church. There will be no entrance
fee for quilts, but the committee
requests patterns of pieced quilts
two weeks before the exhibit.

Quilts over 50 years old, in-
cluding hand-woven coverlets;
modern quilts; three-generation

quilts, pieced by daughter, moth-
er and grandmother; quilts
pieced by men and boys; all oth-
ers.
