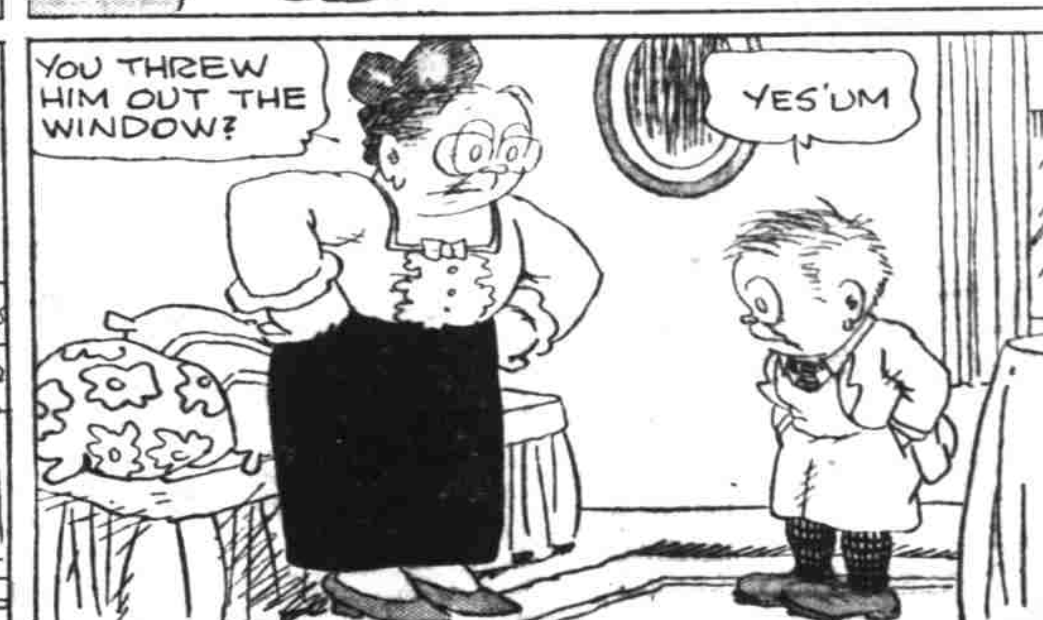
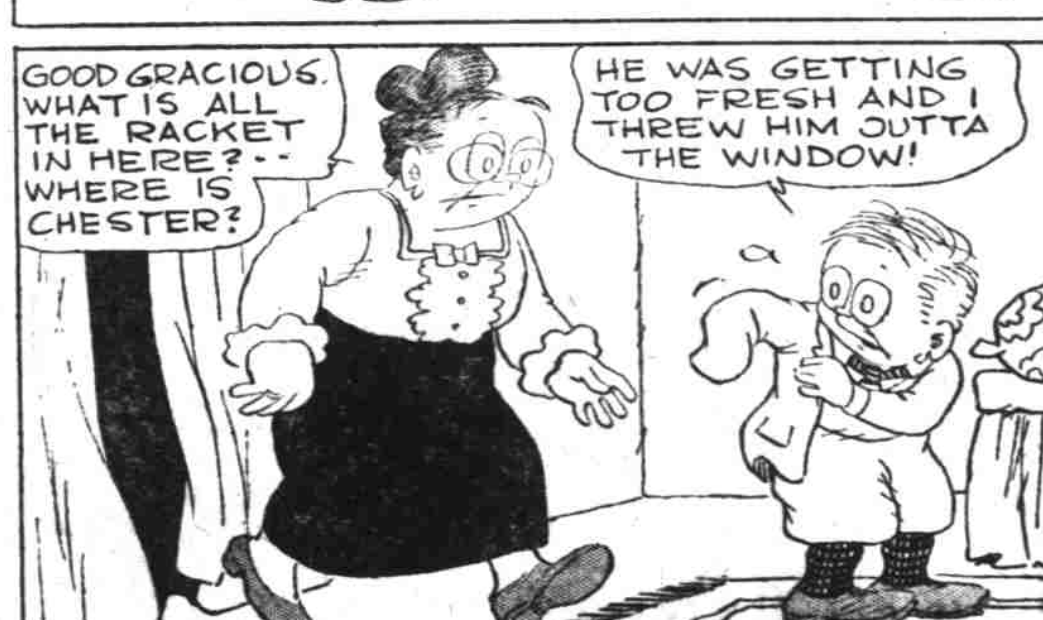
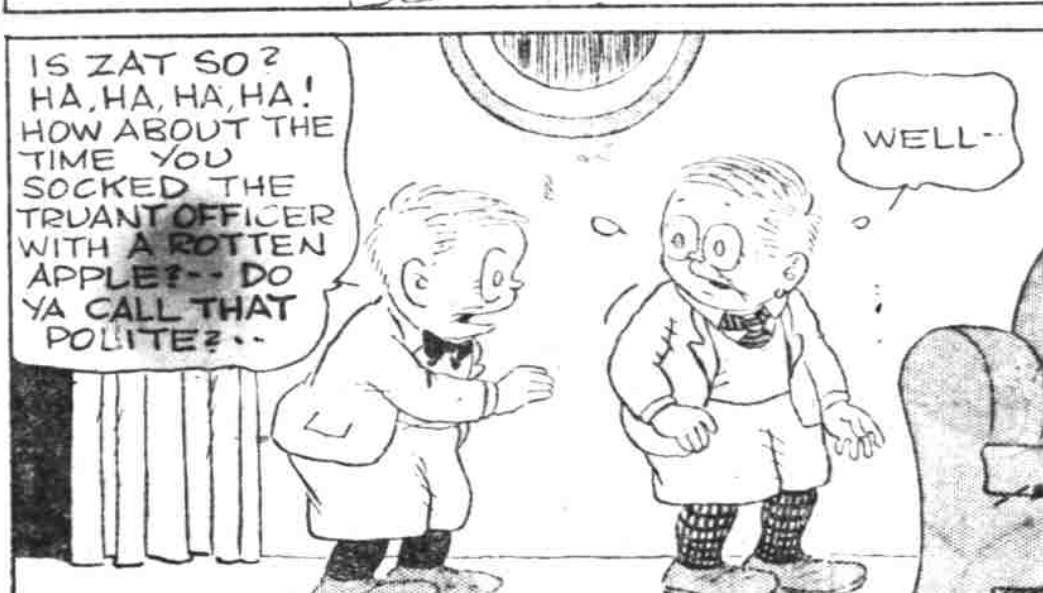
GET ALONG WITH YOU LIGHTNING!

THE RACE CONTINUES IN THIS WAY UNTIL ALL THE PONIES HAVE BEEN RIDDEN. THE TEAM GETTING ALL OF ITS PONIES TO THE GOAL LINE FIRST WINS THE RACE.
