PICKUP IN DEMAND FOR PRUNES NOTED

Cheaper Dollar has Effect; Poland Buys; Market Up Fraction Cent

Demand for dried prunes has picked up considerably since the cheap dollar came into being, and Salem shippers have experienced a fair share of the demand. H. S. Oile and company report considerable interest in the dried prunes, though little in dried berries.

They are shipping one good lot of prunes to Poland and also have on hand another big order. Smaller orders have also been received, so that the stock on hand is being fairly well cleaned up.

The market is up a fraction of a cent, but while this means a trifle more here, the dried goods become cheaper to England, the main buyer at present, because of the currency situation.

There is no inquiry at all on futures, due, it is believed, almost entirely to the lack of exchange. England buyers have no desire to order coming crop when only a big question mark prevails as to the financial situation next October. In addition, there is considerable prune hold-over in Europe, dealers say.

The continued rains may cut some inroads into the prune crop here, it is said now, for trees on the higher points in Polk and Marion counties have not finished blooming, and of course under present weather conditions pollination is not accomplished. With return of warm days right away, the spring buds would be safely cleared for the prune grower.
