FOREST CAMPS OPEN, DETROIT

Breitenbush Road Open now Through to Springs; Start Road Work

DETROIT, June 1 — Two reforestation camps in this area, one located at Hum Bug flat, a mile north of Detroit and one south of the city on Hoover flat, are fully established with equipment and full crews. The boys arrived Wednesday by rail to this vicinity and were taken by stage to their respective camps. The boys all were in good physical condition and all looked capable of doing the task which has been put before them. Their work comprised of trail and telephone maintenance, road construction and snag falling.

Road Open Now
The Detroit-Breitenbush road is opened clear through to the springs, construction and maintenance work has been carried on the past week and the road is in good condition for travel.

Operations will be resumed on the North Santiam highway June 1. Both camps being operated by full crews.

INFLATION RUMOR RAISES GRAINS LOCAL BERRIES ON MARKET SOON

Late Buying Offsets Early Losses at Eastern Lead

CHICAGO, June 1. — (AP) — Reports that new inflationary developments at Washington were forthcoming brought about a sharp recovery of grain values today, and offset early losses.

Eastern interests took the lead in late buying that accompanied stock market upturn. Among rumors current was one that the United States would reduce the gold content of the dollar.

Wheat closed irregular, 1/4 off to 3/4 up compared with yesterday's finish, corn unchanged to 1/4 higher, oats at 1/2 decline to a shade advance.
