CODE FOR LUMBER INDUSTRY ADOPTED

TACOMA, June 8.—(AP)—Adoption of a proposed code for the conduct of the west coast fir lumber industry marked the conclusion here of the two-day session here of the trustees of the West Coast Lumbermen's association. The code has been formulated to accord with the provisions of the industrial recovery act now pending in congress and expected to be passed at an early date. It will be carried to the membership of the industry for discussion and ratification in meetings to be held within the coming week in Washington and Oregon.

Details provisions of the code were not given out at the conclusion of the session, but according to statement of Col. W. B. Greely, secretary-manager of the association, it proposes a control of production among member mills

and is expected to carry out the schedule of wages of the loyal legion of loggers and lumbermen, known as the "4-L," in which employees and employers are both represented.
