BOSTON, June 16.—(AP)—The Commercial Bulletin will say tomorrow:

"The market is stronger for the week, following a very good turnover estimated at 10 and possibly 15 million pounds in consequence of which prices have been advanced generally on territory wools about two cents a pound, clean basis.

"The manufacturing position is exceedingly sound and the mills are giving evidence by their purchase of the fact that they have taken on some heavy commitments on cloth. Better business is reported in prospect for women's wear. Many lines have been withdrawn and repinned higher.

"In the west, the wools are rapidly being cleared with prices falling up to the level of a week ago on free wool.

WOOL TURNOVER IS

"The foreign markets are a bit higher again this week both in Europe and the primary markets. Mohair is very strong at the basis noted a week ago and some houses want more money for their holdings, which are light.
