LIGHT PRODUCTION OF BUTTER IS SEEN

CORVALLIS, Ore., June 20—(AP)—Unchanged butter prices at Portland but slightly weaker tone for lower grades at San Francisco, were reported for the past week today by the USDA bureau of agricultural economics cooperating with the O. S. C. extension service. The larger spread between top and medium quality may work to the detriment of the better grades.

The general tone of the market, even at San Francisco, was not unduly weak as the trade foresees a comparatively light production for the Pacific coast and satisfactory movement of butter into consumption.

The United States storage report released June 12 showed holdings slightly in excess of trade estimates. The into-storage movement last week was slightly greater than for the same period a year ago.

General reports indicate that production is near its peak.

Rising Tendency Seen, Wool Mart

BOSTON, June 20—(AP)—The wool market is fairly strong on 6s and finer western grown wool and prices show a rising tendency. Good French combing and average strictly combing 64s and finer territory wools sold in original bags 70 scoured basis. Choice 12-month Texas wools bring 70 scoured basis and 8-month Texas wools really 65-67 scoured basis in a number of instances.
