

Peasant Awarded Degree
Seventy-nine-year-old Patrick Peterson, a peasant of the parish of Valda, has been awarded an honorary doctor's degree by the University of Upsala. Although he has spent a long life in cultivat-

ing his fields, Peterson used his leisure time to write a book in the dialect and legendary lore of Sweden. It includes a dictionary with more than 36,000 words, also many old songs, fairy tales and proverbs.

ECONOMIC PARLEY REPORTS DRAFTED

LONDON, July 20—(AP)—The world economic conference completed its formal committee work today and prepared its last reports for the monetary and economic commissions before adjournment at plenary session next Thursday.

The most important problems on the agenda of the congress were frankly left for treatment at some indefinite time in the future, including tariffs and import quotas and other trade hindrances, stabilization of currencies, and proposals for agreements to control marketing of important commodities.

Taking stock of results of the deliberations, leaders found that these were: agreement in the silver sub-commission against further debasement of silver coinage and in favor of increasing the uses of the metal; agreement that gold is not needed for internal circulation and that central banks will maintain a minimum reserve; and acceptance of the principle that commercial indebtedness problem requires cooperation by creditor countries to restore a reasonable freedom of trade.

FIVE ARRESTED IN KIDNAPER ROUNDUP

ST. LOUIS, July 20—(AP)—Arrest of five persons alleged to have been implicated directly in the kidnaping of August Luer was followed late today with an announcement that one, Percy Michael Fitzgerald, had admitted his part in the crime.

Activity of 15 department of justice agents and policemen, who had been working on the case without sleep for 50 hours, crystallized into results immediately after Fitzgerald's alleged confession last night.

A series of early morning raids included a visit to a farm house two miles north of East St. Louis, Ill., after identified by police and the kidnap victim himself as the place he was held for more than five days.

Luer, wealthy Alton, Ill., banker, was released unharmed near Collinsville, Ill., Sunday.

Mr. and Mrs. Michael Musiala, the tenants, were two of the five suspects and were arrested tonight. Others were Fitzgerald, Randall Eugene Norvell and Miss Norma Vaughn. A sixth man, Walter "Irish" O'Malley, alias Walter Holland, is sought.

Arkansas Will Legalize Beer

LITTLE ROCK, Ark., July 20—(AP)—Governor Futrell today announced he would call a special session of the legislature to legalize beer just as soon as a working majority in both houses had agreed on a bill.

The governor's action was taken as late returns from Tuesday's election showed the state favored repeal of the prohibition amendment by a majority of 21,000 votes.
