

### M'CORMICK WIDOW BATTLES EVIDENCE

Seeks to Evade Charge of Bringing Gun Used in Killing Jail Bird

NEW YORK, Oct. 5.—(AP)—A young widow accused of bring-

ing her gangster husband a revolver with which he killed a jail keeper and then committed suicide sought to break the chain of evidence wrapped about her by the prosecution today as a witness in the Kings county court. Calmly 21-year-old Cecilia McCormick, widow of Andrew McCormick, faced on the witness stand in her trial for murder a cross-fire of questions in which Judge Taylor participated. She was questioned mainly about her treatment by police after her arrest. Lines of worry and strain show-

ed clearly in her face as she re-  
cited her version of the events  
which led to the slaying of Keeper  
William McConnell and the death  
of "Ginger" McCormick on the  
night of November 24.

She told Judge Taylor and a  
jury she had brought the revolver  
to McCormick at his insistence to  
be used in a suicide pact to release  
themselves from an existence made  
sordid by the shadow of  
prison walls.

The widow said she carried  
with her also two bottles of  
chloroform to be used in case it  
proved impossible to use the weapon.  
In a soft voice she related  
that she was an expectant mother  
at the time, and that she had had  
to borrow \$5 with which to bribe  
a prison guard that she might see  
McCormick, who awaited a long  
sentence to Sing Sing.

At times she trembled and  
swayed in her chair as she testified  
she was "forced" by police  
third degree methods to sign a  
confession that she smuggled the  
revolver to Ginger as part of a  
jail break plot.

A child born to the widow five  
months ago was barred from the  
courtroom by Judge Taylor on the  
ground that every possible element  
of "emotionalism" be omitted  
from the case.
