Tickets for contract bridge classes and the tournament being conducted by The Oregon Statesman with Mrs. William H. Quinn, Culbertson bridge associate, went on sale Thursday at the Marlon hotel for the next day of play, Tuesday, October 10. Tickets may be secured for one afternoon or evening or for the remaining seven days.

A classification of each individual's score made last Tuesday will be available this morning and thereafter at the hotel desk. The sheet will not be posted but any player interested may determine exactly how he or she came out.

The outlook yesterday was for a larger attendance both at the classes and the tournament next Tuesday. Uniformly comment on the classes was excellent while many of the tournament players said they were going to bring their friends next week. Each tournament evening is complete in itself, and if one seeks the grand prizes, only six evenings' play need be turned in, so failure to play in the first round is no handicap.

A Luncheon Menu (Serving Eight)
Chilled Fruit
Creamed Chicken and Rice
Preserved Watermelon Rind
Rolls
Currant Jelly
Stuffed Tomato Salad

Creamed Chicken and Rice
4 tablespoons butter or chicken fat
6 tablespoons flour
2 cup cream
1 cup chicken stock
1 teaspoon salt
1/2 teaspoon paprika
2 tablespoons chopped green peppers
2 tablespoons chopped pimientos
2 1/2 cups diced cooked 2 eggs, beaten
Melt butter and add flour. When blended add cream, milk and stock and cook until thick creamy sauce forms. Stir constantly. Add rest of ingredients and cook two minutes. Pour over mounds of hot buttered rice. Garnish with parsley and serve at once.

Rolls
1 cake compressed yeast
4 tablespoons lukewarm water
1 teaspoon salt
5 tablespoons sugar
1 cup lukewarm milk
4 tablespoons fat, melted
2 eggs
4 1/2 cups flour
Crumble yeast and add water. Let stand 5 minutes. Add salt, sugar, milk, fat, eggs and 2 cups of flour. Beat 2 minutes. Add rest of flour. Mix well. Pour into greased pan or bowl. Cover with cloth and place in a moderate warm place (72 degrees) until dough has doubled in bulk. Roll out dough on floured board and

cut out rolls. Arrange rolls side by side on greased pan. Brush tops with melted butter and let rise until doubled in size. Bake 15 minutes in moderate oven. Serve warm or cold.

Corn Muffins (6)
1/2 cup cornmeal
3/4 cup flour
3 teaspoons baking powder
3/4 teaspoon salt
4 tablespoons sugar
1 egg
1/2 cup milk
1 tablespoon fat, melted
Mix ingredients and beat well. Half fill greased muffin pans and bake 20 minutes in moderately slow oven.

Macaroni and Cheese
3 tablespoons butter
4 tablespoons flour
1 1/2 cups milk
1/2 cup cheese, cut fine
2 tablespoons chopped green peppers
1 teaspoon chopped onion
1/2 teaspoon salt
1/2 teaspoon paprika
2 cups cooked macaroni
Melt butter and add flour. When blended add milk and cook

until thick sauce forms. Stir constantly. Add cheese and stir until it has melted. Add rest of ingredients and pour into buttered baking dish. Bake 25 minutes in moderate oven.

Cottage Pudding
1 cup flour
2 teaspoons baking powder
1/2 teaspoon salt
6 tablespoons sugar
1 egg
1/2 cup milk
2 tablespoons butter
1 teaspoon vanilla
Mix ingredients and beat 1 minute. Pour into shallow greased pan and bake 30 minutes in moderate oven. Serve fresh with lemon or any other fruit sauce.
