Vets' Status for Getting Work Gets Probe by 40 and 8

An investigating committee named by the American vulture, No. 153, 40 and 8 society, went into reemployment records here yesterday afternoon with E. T. Barnes, manager, seeking to ascertain if veterans had been unfairly treated. The investigators were said to have been well satisfied that veterans were being treated equitably.

In a number of instances it was found that veterans with dependents had not been placed because there had been no demand for workers in the classification in which they had registered. Mr. Barnes advised the committee which was headed by O. D. Adams, to have veterans register in classifications where more work was demanded.

Guardian Reports—Ethel Morris, named guardian for Norman Moshberger, a minor, in 1935, filed her final report in probate court Friday. She was allowed \$5 for support of the youth.

Denial Made That Loan Held Up Till Gov. Meier Returns

A statement by Paul Freeman, Polk county farmer, that the land board was powerless to cooperate with him in refinancing a mortgage loan until Governor Meier returned from California brought a prompt denial late yesterday from the executive offices.

The state land board is reported to have said it could not release a 273-page abstract to Freeman except by the latter's posting a \$273 deposit, or securing the assent of Governor Meier. The board was also quoted as saying Acting Governor Kiddle did not have power to serve on the board in lieu of Governor Meier.

The executive offices last night said this was not true, averred that Acting Governor Kiddle did have full power to act. Furthermore, it was stated late yesterday that Acting Governor Kiddle had advised Freeman that he could borrow the abstract he wished to use in his loan application, provided he posted a reasonable bond that the document—a valuable one—be returned.
