RETAIL SHOPS SELL EGGS TOO LOW, SAID

Below Cost Deals Reported; Trading in Butter is Good; Meats Show Strength

PORTLAND, Jan. 18.—(AP)—While the federal law in regard to the selling of products at less than cost was reported in effect, sales of eggs were being openly made 1 to 2c in retail shops below the reported wholesale costs.

The quotation on fresh extras was generally placed 18c dozen here but some retailers were actually selling such supplies at 17c or even a fraction less.

Reports in the trade suggested that wholesalers were shading values 1 to 2c dozen with sales of extras down to 16c but this was generally denied by those reported as participating in the price cutting holiday.

Consumption of eggs was still expanding and was taking care of fresh arrivals.

Trading in the butter market was good here and at recently advanced prices. Consumption continued to gain with the chief call for the standards and prime first offerings. Butterfat was held firm.

Considerable strength was showing in the market for country killed meats and in spots higher prices were reported. Hogs were generally up to 8c for top blockers here with heavy sorts up to 6c lb.

Local demand for turkeys was reported as rather limited. The demand was chiefly for large birds. Buying price was as high as 18 1/2c lb.

Loss of 1c was forced here in the buying price on light and medium weight hens despite the fact that California buying prices have recently shown an advance in these lines.

Small lots of onions were reported selling in the Ladbish section at \$2 net to growers but trading was not at all active even though most of the trade feels that something was going to occur next week.

Cheap cauliflower was disappearing from the market here. California celery was down about 25c crate.

Hop Scene Is Selected For CWA Picture

MONMOUTH, Jan. 18.—Halley Johnson, son of Mr. and Mrs. P. H. Johnson of Monmouth, who is from the art school of the University of Oregon, has been commissioned under the CWA to paint a picture about 33 by 40 inches in exhibition at the art display in the library at Oregon Normal school. A scene of the hop industry has been chosen. This picture becomes the property of the federal government, and is expected to be completed in two weeks.

Mr. Johnson, a native of Monmouth and graduate of all the local schools, including the Oregon Normal school, has been exhibiting his work for several years, capturing many prizes, especially on portraiture, at the state fair. His exhibitions at the art display in Portland last fall were highly praised. His appointment as a CWA artist came through the University of Oregon's art school.
